

MARTHA'S Christmas 3: Free design

Formats: Art 3&4, & 5 Pes, Hus, Jef, Vip 1 & 3

A freestanding lace motif for you to try before you buy.

Embroidery Tips:

- Hooping - taut but not overstretched
- Ensure that your machine's tension is 100% correct or the embroidered lace won't be successful. Test a sample of a small design such as LM0287. If the lace is still 'loose' float another piece of water soluble stabilizer underneath the hoop.
- Water soluble stabilizer- Hoop two layers medium weight water soluble stabilizer
- Ensure that the needle is in a good condition. - needle (75)
- Embroidery thread - 40 weight. For bobbin thread wind quite a few bobbins with the same embroidery thread.
- Jumps have been limited to a minimum.
- Ensure that no trailing bobbin or embroidery threads remain on top or underneath the hooped stabilizer or it will be sewn into the lace and it is not easy to remove once the embroidery is done.
- FSL - Freestanding lace
- WSS – Water soluble stabilizer

Color: white
Size: H2.81 x W 2.74



Tip from Martha: Need to stiffen any of the projects?

When stitching FSL cut the excess WSS away from the design. All the cut-offs can be used later to stiffen the lace if needed. Mix equal amounts of water and WSS. This makes a supersaturated solution that can be painted on the lace or the lace can be dipped in it. When dried the lace will be stiffened.
